The Lochaber Challenger Regatta will be held over the 9/10th Sept 2017 weekend.

Entries are welcome for the Gold, and Bronze fleets as defined by the Challenger Association and will comprise 5 races. If there is sufficient time a “helpers” race will be run at the end.

Registration will be from 0930 hrs on the Saturday with a briefing at 1015 hrs. The format will be three races on Saturday with the first starting at 1100 hrs. There will be a break for lunch then there will be races 2 and 3. On Sunday Race 4 will start at 10:30 hrs and race 5 sometime thereafter. A helpers race will be held if time and weather permit. The aim is to finish the last race by approximately 15:00 hrs on Sunday.

A fee of £25.00 is being charged which may be paid in advance or at registration. Cheques should be made payable to Lochaber Yacht Club.

Note: A boat is responsible for her own safety and nothing in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions reduces this responsibility. It is for- the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in those conditions in which she finds herself, and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them. The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular, to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage death or personal injury however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the racing, and include the race officer, patrol boats and beach crews. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibilities.
